FORMED SUBSCRIPTION ENDING

For several years SJC Chapel has had a subscription to FORMED. Our subscription will lapse on September 11. The main reason for this is that I am not sure if anyone is actually using it: FORMED does not provide usage numbers, and attempts to gain testimonials about FORMED from the worshipping community did not receive any responses. The group that historically promoted FORMED the most – the SJC Lighthouse Group – has moved on; besides there being little new content that they wished to use, FORMED no longer provides digital copies of study guides, and since Lighthouse has several members who can only attend meetings via Zoom, this is not ideal. The FORMED subscription has been supported by donations, but this year the cost has mostly been supported by the College. I cannot say we are getting value for the money, so it is better, I think, to allow our subscription to end.
