If you are interested in learning more about the process of becoming a member of the Roman Catholic Church, contact Fr. Warren at wrschmid@ualberta.ca to get more information, and to be included in future updates. Some people are already on the list!

The program begins late in September or early October, and is based on mass attendance with a sponsor (a "mass buddy" who can answer questions you might have, and provide support). Instruction is provided by programs offered through Campus Ministry and the Catholic Students Association. If all goes well, reception into the Church would happen at Easter, at the end of March, 2027.

This process is also open to Catholics who still need to be confirmed.

As far as paperwork goes, there is a form that needs to be filled out, and a baptized person will need to provide a copy of their baptismal certificate; an unbaptized person will need a copy of their birth certificate.
