PARKING ISSUES AND A SEARCH FOR A SOLUTION

As you may know, the parking lot behind the Kateri residence is on leave alone during mass times; you can park there without getting ticketed by U of A parking services. Unfortunately, this fact has become widely known, and many people park there on weekends for reasons other than mass (e.g. to go to the gym). At last Sunday's 7 pm mass only one quarter of the spaces were available for church parking. This is clearly a problem.

We are not entirely sure how to solve the problem, but the first step seems to be to identify which vehicles are legitimately there. Accordingly we now have a SJC Chapel Parking Sign In sheet. Please sign in if you plan to use the Kateri lot and would otherwise be at the risk of being ticketed. (If you pay the monthly fee to park there, you don't need to sign in.)

The plan is to have Parking Services ticket cars in the lot that are not authorized. It is therefore very important that at-risk individuals sign the sheet. We won't call Parking Services during the masses this weekend, but when we do, we don't want our parishioners caught up in the operation. It is thus important that we know whose cars belong to them.

If you ever receive a ticket that you don't deserve, please submit a copy to Fr. Jim, and I'll try to get it cancelled.
