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CHAPEL WORSHIP SURVEY

The Chapel Worship Survey is in the final stages of approval. I hope to have a link to it available next week. There are a number of questions about areas of improvement that I would like to give you advance notice of, since they would benefit from reflection.

One question concerns improvement in amenities. In the past few years we have added screens to the windows, extra pews, and replaced the west door to the College. What other changes of this sort could we make?

There is also a question on the ways in which the chapel could be more beautiful, or the liturgies better. New art has to go through a committee, but a suggestion can come from anywhere.

The 100th anniversary is coming up, and could be marked by a somewhat ambitious project. Another question asks for suggestions about what such a project might look like.

I have been informed that a successful bid was made for the contract to replace the ceiling fans. They will be installed during Fall reading week (November 10-14). All the ceiling lights will be replaced at that time.
