Instruction is provided by programs offered through Campus Ministry and the Catholic Students Association. If all goes well, reception into the Church would happen at Easter, at the end of March, 2027.

This process is also open to Catholics who still need to be confirmed.

As far as paperwork goes, there is a form that needs to be filled out, and an unbaptized person will only need a copy of their birth certificate; a baptized person will also need to provide a copy of their baptismal certificate in addition to a birth certificate.
