This Data Sovereignty Declaration recognizes and declares that each research participant that took part in the study entitled

is the rightful owner of the digital recording of their visiting. They are also the Intellectual Property Rights holder and Copyright owner of the digital recording of their visiting. The purpose of this document is to identify how each participant wants the digital recording of their visiting cared for in the present, the future, and in perpetuity. This is of great importance because Indigenous verb-based languages gift Indigenous Sovereignty to Indigenous peoples.

As the rightful owners of the digital recording of your visiting, this document identifies:

- 1 **Who** you want to **appoint** to be the **data caretaker** of the digital copy of your visiting;
- 2 **Who** you want to have **access** to a digital copy of your visiting;
- 3 **Where** you want a digital copy of your visiting to be **stored**;
- 4 **How long** you want a digital copy of your visiting **preserved**; and
- 5 **Why** you want to have a digital copy of your visiting **saved**.

You may change your mind and request that a digital copy of your visiting be removed from a place of storage and/or access be changed and/or removed at any time by communicating your wishes verbally in-person, over the phone, through an email or in a written letter to Dr. Florence Glanfield.

Once you have completed your earth walk, your self-appointed data caretaker will become the rightful owner of the digital recording of your visiting if you choose to assign them with the Intellectual Property Rights and Copyright of the digital recording of your visiting. **Each data caretaker will be responsible for passing any necessary information down to subsequent generations to facilitate access to the digital recording of your visiting as per this Data Sovereignty Declaration and Care Taking Directives.**

IMPLEMENTING YOUR DATA SOVEREIGNTY DECLARATION AND CARE TAKING DIRECTIVES

Following the directives provided in this document, the SILR research team will:

1

Create a digital copy of your visiting.

2

Provide a copy of your Data Sovereignty Declaration with your Care Taking Directives to the identified third parties.

3

Once the third parties review, agree to, and sign your Data Sovereignty Declaration and Care Taking Directives, a digital copy of your visiting will be provided to the third parties within a month of the Data Sovereignty Declaration and Care Taking Directives being signed.

4

Once the third parties review, agree to, and sign your Data Sovereignty Declaration and Care Taking Directives, a digital copy of the Data Sovereignty Declaration and Care Taking Directives will be provided to your self-appointed data caretaker (if you have appointed someone) within a month of the Data Sovereignty Declaration and Care Taking Directives being signed.



AGREEMENT TO DATA SOVEREIGNTY DECLARATION AND CARE TAKING DIRECTIVES

By signing this Data Sovereignty Declaration and Care Taking Directives, the third parties identified below agree that the research participant is the rightful owner of the digital recording of their visiting as well as the Intellectual Property Rights holder and Copyright holder, and the third party will follow the directives set out in this Data Sovereignty Declaration and Care Taking Directives in the present, the future, and in perpetuity. The third parties also agree not to sell or make money off of the recording of the visiting and will not share, distribute, or modify the digital recording of the research participant's visiting in any way or manner, unless authorized by this agreement.

If a third party breaches this Data Sovereignty Declaration and Care Taking Directives, they will immediately lose permission to store and/or share digital copies of the recording of the visiting and need to immediately remove/delete any digital copies of the recording of the visiting from their archive/data storage and return the provided USB (and any copies) to the current data caretaker. If money was made off of the recording of the visiting, all money will be immediately returned to the data caretaker.

The parties agree as follows:

1

The named research participant retains copyright in the digital recording of their visiting. The third parties identified below agree that the participant is the rightful owner of the digital recording of their visiting.

2

The participant hereby grants a nonexclusive, noncommercial license to the Principal Investigator of the SILR research team to reproduce and distribute an unadapted digital copy or copies of the video of the participant's visiting in accordance with the participant's directions and the terms set out in this Data Sovereignty Declaration and Care Taking Directives. The participant agrees that the Principal Investigator can designate any member of the SILR research team to do any actions needed pursuant to this license.

The participant hereby grants a nonexclusive, noncommercial license to the data caretaker to reproduce and distribute an unadapted digital copy or copies of the video of their visiting in accordance with the participant's directions and the terms set out in this Data Sovereignty Declaration and Care Taking Directives.

4

The participant hereby grants a nonexclusive, noncommercial license to the audiovisual digital curation platform AVIARY to host an unadapted digital copy of the recording of the participant's visiting in AVIARY's archive, and allow access to the recording to those granted access by the Participant and/or the data caretaker.

The participant hereby grants a nonexclusive, noncommercial license to the audiovisual digital curation platform AVIARY to host an unadapted digital copy of the recording of the participant's visiting on the SILR website, accessible for public viewing.

By signing this Data Sovereignty Declaration and Care Taking Directives, the participant and the parties agree that the third parties identified below can have a digital copy of the recording of the visiting and the licenses set out above as long as they adhere to the directives set out in this Data Sovereignty Declaration and Care Taking Directives in the present, the future, and in perpetuity. For greater certainty, this agreement and Data Sovereignty Declaration and Care Taking Directives will be binding on any successor in interest to, or assign of, any of the parties.
