



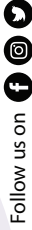
Charmaine Dean

Her research is motivated by real applications to important practical problems in biostatistics and ecology, and she is currently looking at mapping disease and mortality rates, survival after coronary artery bypass surgery, forest ecology, fire management, flood analysis, just to list a few. She has won several awards including the CRM-SSC Prize in Statistics (2003) and the Trinidad & Tobago Canadian High Commission Award (2012).
