The MacEwan University Health Centre (MUHC) is a unique collaboration between the University of Alberta Department of Family Medicine and MacEwan University. Borne from the Dept. of FM's desire to develop an innovative clinic based on the tenets of the Patient-Centered Medical Home, the MUHC officially opened its doors to patient care, and Residents, on July 3rd, 2018. The MUHC not only services >5000 community patients previously cared for by our physician group out of the Royal Alexandra Family Medicine Centre (RAFMC), but also all MacEwan University student and staff health needs. The MUHC preceptors have over twenty years of experience delivering innovative primary care, and Resident teaching, through their previous work at the RAFMC.

The MUHC has been designed (both in structure and function) to deliver comprehensive, collaborative, team-based care. By joining our team, you will have the opportunity to see practice improvement and innovations in patient care happen in 'real-time', and experience staff working in expanded scopes of practice to support our patients' needs.
