#### INTRODUCTION BY THE RESEARCH DIRECTOR



There is a growing international movement toward universities becoming responsive to the priorities and needs of the communities they serve. This emphasis on social accountability is most evident in the health sciences, as it is

considered to be a key strategy to improve the quality and equity of health services. Our department's mission stresses a culture of accountability and emphasizes that research should address the needs of the society of which we are a part of. Several examples of how our research has addressed the social accountability mandate are highlighted below.

Our faculty members are conducting research projects that address the needs of a broad spectrum of patient population groups, including disadvantaged populations (addictions, homelessness), maternal health, care of the elderly, medically at-risk drivers, patients with various chronic diseases (hypertension, cardiovascular disease, mental health, diabetes, lung disease, cancer, cognitive impairment, obesity,), patients with multi-morbidities, sports injuries, family caregivers, and lifestyle issues. A number of new projects were funded for  $\geq$  \$1,000,000 each to address priority concerns originating from the community of practice. These include: (1) 'Data Presentation Tool' in primary care clinics to enhance the surveillance, prevention and management of chronic disease; (2) Alberta SPOR Primary and Integrated Health Care Innovation Network; (3) BedMed Initiative - making better use of existing therapeutics; (4) BETTER-WISE: building on existing tools to improve cancer and chronic disease prevention and screening in primary care; and (5) CHANGE cancer Alberta project.

Our evidence-based medicine group regularly publishes "Tools for Practice" which address questions encountered in clinical practice and provide clinicians the best evidence for the care provided to patients.

Special congratulations are extended to two of our esteemed colleagues, Drs. Neil Bell and Andrew Cave, for receiving the 2016 CFPC Lifetime Achievement Award in Family Medicine Research. Dr. Bell's research has ranged from early development of a computerized information system to inform practice, to the development of clinical practice guidelines. Dr. Cave has extensively studied

asthma and COPD and has informed the development of asthma pathways and guidelines.

Our research actively engages with the community of practice. The Northern and Southern Alberta Primary Care Research Networks continue to contribute to the Canadian Primary Care Sentinel Surveillance Network, providing data for quality improvement and research. The Pragmatic Trials Collaborative works with community physicians to evaluate whether practice changes are affecting important patient-oriented outcomes. EnACt (Enhancing Alberta Primary Care Research Networks) provides infrastructure to support and enhance Alberta's existing practice-based research networks as well as academic and community practitioners conducting primary care research. Social accountability extends to our learners. The research curriculum provides family medicine residents with the skills required to improve practice through practice quality improvement projects (PQI). PQI is essential to improving the health of the population and patient outcomes.

Care of the Elderly resident, Dr. Karen Leung, received the national CFPC Research Award for Family Medicine Residents for her research project, "Melatonin for the Prevention of Delirium and Management of Evening Behavioural Disturbances in Dementia."

The Competency-Based Achievement System (CBAS) medical education research team has developed electronic resources to assess learner competencies. This innovative work received the 2015 Information Technology Excellence Award.

We enjoy outstanding research support from our administrative team who provide methodological, study implementation, financial, and human resources support. Congratulations to Carolina Aguilar who received the 2015 University of Alberta Support Staff Research Enhancement Award which recognizes staff who consistently make a positive contribution to the research success of their department, faculty, and/or the university.

Only a few of the outstanding research activities have been highlighted in this introduction. Many more are detailed in this report. Enjoy the read!




