- Fabric container
- Soil
- Seeds
- Watering supply (hose, watering wand, watering can)
- Fertilizer

The costs

- Costs will vary depending on size of container and associated supplies
- Equipment can be reused the following years
- Estimated costs: about \$220 for one outdoor garden container (fabric container, soil, seeds, fertilizer, water)

- Two Edmonton schools participated in 2017 (grades 2 and 5)
- One school only planted carrots the other school planted a variety of vegetables
