In healthcare, a conscientious professional should recognize the obligation to openly discuss death as part of one's fiduciary duty to the patient. In this presentation I will consider what the source of this taboo may be, whether cultural or professional, and discuss strategies to honestly and compassionately approach this difficult conversation.
