**Selection Committee:** The selection committee will consist of three (3) members: the Orchesis Director, one Orchesis Faculty member, and one member at large selected by the Orchesis Executive Board (who is not personally applying for the award). Some of the criteria for consideration are listed below:

An active member and good standing may be defined as:

- Regularly attends and participates in dance class or classes of choice/placement
- Is or has been involved in the production of Dance Motif through one or all of dancing, choreographing, and or working backstage, or front of house to promote the event
- Has shown a keen interest in advancing personal dance studies in and outside of Orchesis
- Is actively involved in Orchesis volunteer and/or leadership efforts through any of Motif ticket sales, workshops, fundraising, volunteer and/or extended executive events, serving on committees and so on.
- Although this award is not based on a student's university GPA, the recipient's academic standing must be satisfactory. (Minimum 2.0 GPA for undergraduates, minimum for 2.7 for Graduates)
- Applicant may be from any U of A faculty or department program.
