Students admitted to this program identify a supervisor after completion of full-time coursework during the first year of enrollment.</p>	<p>1. English Language Proficiency:</p> <p>English is the primary language of instruction at the University of Alberta and all applicants must be proficient in English. Refer to the FGSR English Language Proficiency Requirement.</p> <p>If your earlier education was at a foreign academic institution, and that school is not recognized by the University of Alberta as having <u>English language instruction</u>, you will require one of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL)</u>: Minimum score of 600 (paper version), 250 (electronic version), 100 (internet version).

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • International English Language Testing System (IELTS): minimum overall band score of 7.0 with no less than a score of 6.0 on each band. • Pearson Test of English Academic (PTE): minimum overall score of 68 <p>2. Graduate Record Exam (GRE) Physics Score</p> <p>Minimum score of 850 on the GRE Physics subject test.</p> <p>3. Supervisor Not Required Prior to Admission:</p> <p>Medical Physics applicants are not required to identify a potential supervisor prior to applying for admission.
