

Global Health Bursary Recipient Poster

Students who received a GH bursary are required to produce a poster about the elective and what they learned from the experience. All the posters will be displayed on February 3, 2020 at the Global Health Fair Symposium, from 11 am - 6 pm in ECHA 2-420. Poster viewing will be all day but there will be a poster presentation session at approximately 1700h. Please prepare to come and spend at least one hour with your poster telling viewers about it. There will be a prize for the best poster!

It's going to be a great day of celebrating Global Health in FoMD and your poster will be a key part of the event. Collectively the posters make a bold statement about the value of Global Health initiatives, the importance of international electives for medical and health science students and the benefit of these experiences both for the learner and for the host institution. We'll show the rest of the faculty and university a bit of what the Global Health Program is all about.

Guidelines for poster:

- 1) Size recommended 30" x 24", (this size is preferred) and can be no larger than: 36" tall x 48" wide
- 2) Determine the message you want to convey to the viewer as a focus for the poster
- 3) Sections to include:
 - a) Title with your name and identification
 - b) Background including where you went and something about the country
 - c) What you did
 - d) What you learned and your key message
 - e) Include photographs and other visuals. All types of creativity are encouraged...take a risk and try something new to convey your message.

If your clerkship rotation or other school activity will interfere with you presenting your poster please drop off your poster at ECHA 2-115 prior to February 3. A representative from the Global Health office will post it up for you.
