Class - Years 1 & 2

- Dress in routine class in the first two years is informal
- In more formal situations, such as exams and any clinical scenarios, visible underwear is inappropriate

Anatomy Lab

- Scrubs or respectful informal clothing is allowed
- A long white lab coat and hospital ID must be worn at all times
- No open-toed shoes are allowed

Clinical Wear - Years 3 & 4

- Students are required to wear a clean, short white clinical coat with their hospital ID
- Appropriate attire for men includes:
 - O Press shirts (polo shirts, golf shirts, button down shirts) or sweaters
 - o Long pants (trousers, khakis, or dress pants)
 - o No undershirts, tank tops, or offensive material on clothing
 - o No shorts, blue jeans, track pants, or sweatpants
- Appropriate attire for women includes:
 - Professional sweaters, blouses or dress shirts
 - o Dress pants, khakis, or appropriate-length skirts
 - No spaghetti straps, strapless, or halter tops without a cover-up and no offensive material on clothing
 - o No plunging necklines or exposed mid-riffs
 - o No miniskirts, shorts, blue jeans, track pants, or sweatpants
- Shoes should be neat and clean, and close-toed.
- Refrain from wearing perfume, cologne and excessive jewelry
