IMMEDIATELY (with blood or body fluid exposure):

- 1. Remove contaminated gloves, clothes, etc.
- For sharps injury allow bleeding for 1-2
 minutes do not squeeze. Wash area with
 soap and water or alcohol based hand rub
 and cover with a dressing.
- 3. For mucous membrane exposure (e.g. eyes, nose, mouth) and non-intact skin, flush with large amounts of water for 10-15 minutes.
- 4. Report incident to the Charge Nurse and your supervisor immediately to complete Source Risk Assessment & obtain first aid.
- 5. Follow facility specific reporting protocol. If you are at AHS facility call 1-888-482-8550.

REPORTING:

All incidents, home or abroad <u>must</u> be reported to the Undergraduate Medical Office within <u>48</u> hours.

To report visit www.ehs.ualberta.ca and:

- 6. Complete the on-line University of Alberta Incident Report within 48 hours.
- 7. Complete the Alberta WCB Worker's Report of Injury within 48 hours by following the injury or incident links.
