Notes:

- MLCS 210 should be taken in your first or second year. MLCS 410 should be taken in the final winter semester of your degree. MLCS 410 is offered in the Winter semester only. MLCS 495 (thesis) is taken in your final year, normally Fall term. Students doing combined honors replace MLCS 495 with INT D 520 and must apply to the Faculty of Arts Undergraduate Student Services by August 1.
- + 36 credits at the senior-level in French OR split between French and another language (with at least 12 credits in each). Depending on your language placement, you may need to complete FREN 111/112/211/212/297/298 before completing the other course requirements. FREN 211/212/297/298 count towards the 54-60 credits of your major.
- If choosing two languages of focus, the second language must be offered by MLCS. You must have at least 6* credits in both languages at the senior level.
- Recommended courses include: FREN 311, 315, 317, 318, 319, 333 345, 354, 399, 418, 433 445, 454, 465, 468, 478, 479, 481, 499.
- Experiential learning courses within this route normally include MLCS 210 (opt in), MLCS 410, La Rochelle, France (FREN 333/433); e3 French Alps, & Explore Quebec. Experiential learning credits can also be met through MLCS courses that include [significant experiential learning components](#) appropriate to the area of study, Community Service-Learning (CSL), Arts Work Experience (AWE), OR a study abroad experience or in Francophone areas of Canada. Six credits total, in any combination. For help with the Experiential learning component consult the Academic advisor to access our Experiential Learning guide
