Aside from the GPS form that must be completed by the student and supervisor(s), the following documentation must be provided to GPS:

- From the student: An explanatory outlining the reasons for the delay in progress.
- Timeline of work completed since the last doctoral program requirements extension was approved. Please create a chart with dates on one side and tasks completed on the other.
- Timeline to candidacy completion and program completion. Please create a chart with dates on one side and tasks to be completed on the other.
- From the supervisor: An explanatory letter summarizing the student's progress to date, and supporting the request for an extension as well as the timeline proposed by the student.
