This document provides a guide about the best sequencing for taking your courses in the MN program.

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SPECIAL NOTES

- 1. *Advanced focus courses for MN <u>EDUCATION</u> and MN <u>LEADERSHIP</u> are only offered every second year (2022-2023, 2024-2025, 2026-2027)
 - a. Education Advanced Focus Courses:
 ADVANCED FOCUS A: NURS 558 (Fall) and
 ADVANCED FOCUS B: NURS 559 (Winter)
 - Leadership Advanced Focus Courses:
 ADVANCED FOCUS A: NURS 568 (Fall) and ADVANCED FOCUS B: NURS 569 (Winter)
- 2. MN students must complete NURS 591 in spring before registering in NURS 900 in fall (Capstone)
- 3. MN <u>Course-based</u> students may not have full-time registration in Fall or Winter terms of Year 2. This may affect eligibility for awards that require FT status, and student loan repayment. Students can consider either switching to the thesis route or choosing to take one additional elective course to maintain FT status.
