## **Course Delivery Formats Offered**

### **On campus only**

All students will participate in face-to-face classes scheduled for attendance on campus.

### **Online only**

All students will participate virtually in online course delivery.

Students should plan to be regularly available for the specific day/time that appears in the timetable for lectures, discussion, and other learning activities.

Instructors will determine the balance between synchronous and asynchronous class activities.

Courses appear on Beartracks as "Class taught **synchronously** via eClass".

### **Hybrid (formerly known as Blended) – Concurrent on-campus & online delivery**

The course will have 2 registration sections: one online and one on-campus. All students participate in a class timetabled for a regularly scheduled day and time.

Students registered in the online section will participate by video technology concurrently with on-campus students in classroom lectures and learning activities.
