- Three themes:
 - Blended and Collaborative Approaches to KT

- Productive and Focused Conversations:
 - Requires commitment from <u>ALL</u> participants
 - Overall Hosts
 - Table Hosts
 - 'Meta Questions' and prompts
 - Creative expression and lateral thinking
 - Building a conversation over time
 - Whole-group Conversation



Overall Host

- Introduces the conversation
- Gets the conversation started
- Overseas the conversation ambience
- Manages the movement in conversations



Role of Table Host

- Set out the Meta-Question
- Keep the conversation focused and flowing
- Use 'prompts' to help with the conversation
- Role model recording of conversation and 'being creative'
- Ensure equality of participation
