- Introduces the conversation
- Gets the conversation started
- Oversees the conversation ambience
- Manages the movement in conversations



- Set out the Meta-Question
- Keep the conversation focused and flowing
- Use 'prompts' to help with the conversation
- Role model recording of conversation and 'being creative'
- Ensure equality of participation
