


# **Notes on Specific Courses**

ENGL (*3) or WRS (*3)	ENGL (*3) or WRS (Writing Studies) (*3) is recommended to be taken in Fall Term of Year 1; Students may alternatively take ENGL or WRS in the Winter Term, but it fits more easily in the Fall Term Schedule.
	If there is no ENGL or WRS available, students may take an elective (scheduled in Year 2) in Fall Year 1 and take ENGL or WRS in Spring/Summer of Year 2.
	If credit has previously been obtained for ENGL (*3) or WRS (*3), it does not need to be taken again for the BScN program.
Electives (*3) (6 credits total)	6 credits total worth of electives are a part of the BScN program requirements. These are recommended to be taken in the Spring/ Summer of the 1st and 2nd year of the program (3 credits each; they must be taken prior to the start of the 4th year of the program.
	Students who are interested in the Fast Track option must take the second elective prior to the end of Year 2 Winter term.
	If a total of 6 credits has previously been obtained for electives, additional electives are not needed.
	The Faculty of Nursing has two asynchronous courses that students can enroll in to fulfil their elective requirements INT D 247 Resilience and INT D 249 The Science of Joy and Happiness. There will be enrollment spaces allocated for Nursing students who wish to enroll in these courses.

# **Notes on Specific Courses**

Electives (*3) (6 credits total)	Students who are interested in the Fast Track option must take the second elective prior to the end of Year 2 Winter term.
	If a total of 6 credits has previously been obtained for electives, additional electives are not needed.
NURS 216A/B	NURS 216 is a two-term course. Registration in both NURS 216A and NURS 216B components must be done separately.
	Students must enroll in the same section (C01/C02), and corresponding pattern in both Fall and Winter terms.
	Students must complete both A&B enrollments on the same day, otherwise the course will be dropped.

Choose one of the following options for Fall semester.

Students will take either NURS 322/323 or NURS 327 during Fall, and the other course during Winter.

**NURS 322** (Maternal/Child Nursing Practice) and **NURS 323** (Community Nursing Through the Lifespan) are offered jointly over Fall term. Each course runs for 3 weeks and students will either start with NURS 322 and then take NURS 323 or vice versa.





# **Notes on Clinical Placements**

Clinical practice preparation prior to the start of clinicals is required in addition to direct course hours. Details are included in the course outline.

Assigned times for Clinicals (e.g. 6:30am-11pm, 12:01am-11:59pm) indicate the possible ranges of time when clinical shifts may be scheduled.

The shifts will be assigned by the clinical setting, specifics on the times and locations will be provided in the course notes. Hybrid Clinical Learning Days may also be scheduled as a part of Clinicals.

After the registration deadline (**June 15th**), students will be set up in HSPnet and assigned their placements. Students should not attempt to register themselves into different sections thereafter to swap placements.

If you have already completed your placement request for NURS 485 and you have serious concerns about your placement, i.e., health concerns, academic concerns, or a conflicting UNE position, please contact **nursing.preceptorship@ualberta.ca**.

Students may not go to a unit/area where they have worked or have a relative working on the unit. Please notify the Faculty as soon as possible following the posting of clinical groups if you find you are placed where you work or have worked.
