

Important Update Regarding CHEM164/261 and CHEM263

Starting in Summer 2020, the Department of Chemistry will not be offering CHEM261 or CHEM263 due to the inability to deliver in-person laboratories. Instead, CHEM264/266 and CHEM265/267 will be offered. CHEM 264 and 265 contain all the theory of the traditional organic chemistry courses and the respective CHEM 266 and 267 have virtual laboratory exercises that will substitute for the in-person laboratory components.

The Department of Pharmacology will accept CHEM264 + 266 and CHEM265 + 267 as substitutes for CHEM164/261 and CHEM263, respectively. For more information on the content and grading of these courses, please contact the Department of Chemistry.
