

# Renewable Resources Distributed Learning Centre – SAB 150

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The Renewable Resources Distributed Learning Centre is a multi-use, high-tech, smart video classroom designed to facilitate distributed learning, research collaboration, and professional education. It is located in the South Academic Building, Room 1-50.

## Facilities

- Natural lighting with closeable blinds and dimmable LED lighting.
- 43 seat capacity, set up in front-facing fixed classroom style (tiered)
- Table mounted microphones and power outlets shared between every 2 people in the audience
- Lapel mic available for instructor/speaker
- Distance Software under *MS Windows: Skype For Business, WebX, Go-to-Meeting, Fuse; others as required*
- Podium
  - Height adjustable
  - Touch panel control
  - Three podium monitors, one of which has the capability for on-screen pen writing
  - Document camera
  - External lap-top port
- Dual 10' retractable projection screens with full-length whiteboards behind, supplemented by two mid-room ceiling mounted TV screens.
- Two zoom-on-location cameras that respond to microphone input; with floor 'touch' pad for camera control when using whiteboard or screens

## Training

- Users require training on the equipment and software, and pre-room testing.
- Training is done by ALES IT staff during normal business hours.
- Ideally, there should be a person present during use that has adequate knowledge to monitor externals, camera action, etc.

## Times available

Monday to Friday 8:30 am to 5:00 pm; allow at least 30 minutes set up time with ALES IT staff. Currently there is no capacity for weekend or evening bookings. However, special requests will be considered on a case-by-case basis. There will be increased costs associated with overtime for technical staff.
