



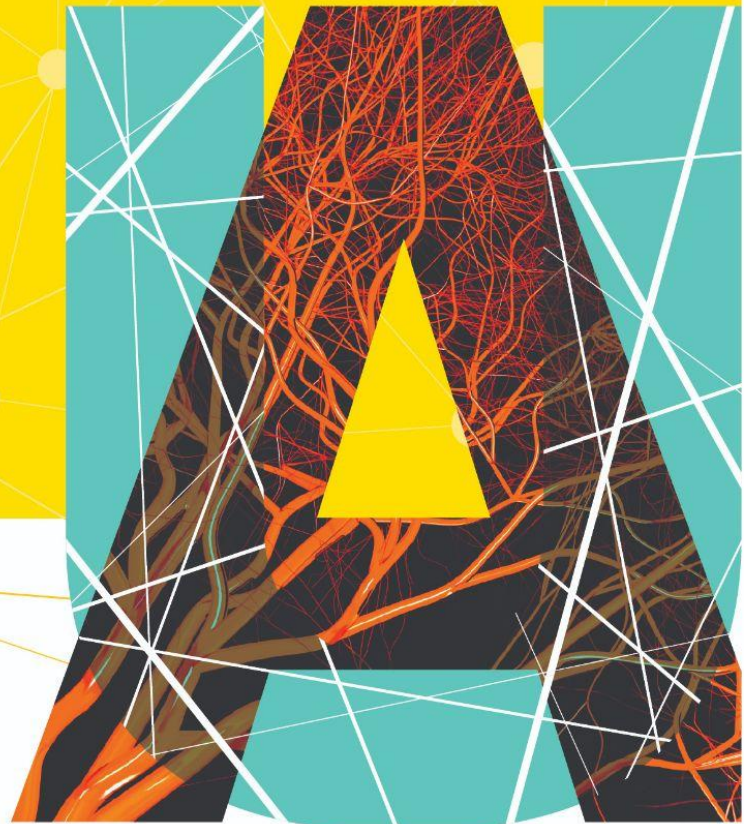

Frequently Asked Questions

Are there any prerequisites for the IV sedation program?

No, you just need to be registered in Canada to take our course and have a valid Heart and Stroke Foundation CPR registration. If you do not have H+S CPR please ensure you complete this program prior to your ACLS training in Session 2.

Any special requirements for dentists from out of province?

You must apply with the CDSA in Alberta for a courtesy license while you are working on patients here in Alberta. We can assist you with this. If you are from out of province we need you to submit a Letter of Good Standing to us as well.

Do I need to take the sessions in order?

Yes, they must be.

When are the payments due for each session?

They are due 3 months prior to the start of each session.

Do I need to provide my own patients for the IV Session 3?

No, we provide all 21 sedation cases for you.

If I have taken the Nitrous program at the U of A in the past do I need to retake it?

No, as long as you have taken the program in the last year, you do not need to retake the program. You will also receive a refund for your original Nitrous course you enrolled in as long it's within the 1 year period.

Do I need to provide dental assistants for Session 3?

It is highly recommended that you bring the assistants that will be helping you with IV sedation to Session 3. They will receive their Sedation Assistant Certificate as well. If you do not bring your dental assistant there is a fee of \$1500 per RDA for us to provide one for you.
