## REQUIRED DOCUMENT INFORMATION

#### Citizenship and Residency

All applicants must be Canadian citizens or permanent residents of Canada on or before **November 1**. Proof of a valid Canadian citizenship or permanent resident status is required.

Uploaded documents must include both front and back sides (excluding passports).

### **Dental Marks/Transcripts and Internship Certificate**

Transcripts must be provided for all post-secondary work completed in the past or present.

Dental transcripts (or mark sheets) must detail **all courses taken** and grades received, including failed and repeated courses, within each term/year. Summaries are NOT accepted.

A copy of a rotating internship certificate must be provided for applicants who have completed a rotating/compulsory internship.

#### **Dental Degree**

A copy of the dental degree is required if the provided transcript does not indicate that the degree was conferred/awarded/granted.

#### **License to Practice Dentistry**

Applicants who are, or have been, licensed to practice dentistry in any jurisdiction, must upload proof of licensure from current and previous licensing bodies.

#### **Certificate of Good Standing**

Applicants who are, or have been, licensed to practice dentistry in any jurisdiction, must upload letters of good standing (in English) from current and previous licensing bodies.

## **Advanced Dental Admission Test (ADAT)**

The ADAT is only offered between **March 1 to August 31** of each year.

Results must be sent **directly** from the ADA to the University of Alberta.

## **English Proficiency Requirements**

English is the primary language of instruction at the University of Alberta. All applicants must be proficient in both written and spoken English.

English tests must be no older than 2 years on November 1.
