SJC's Librarian talks at local Library Consortium Miniconference

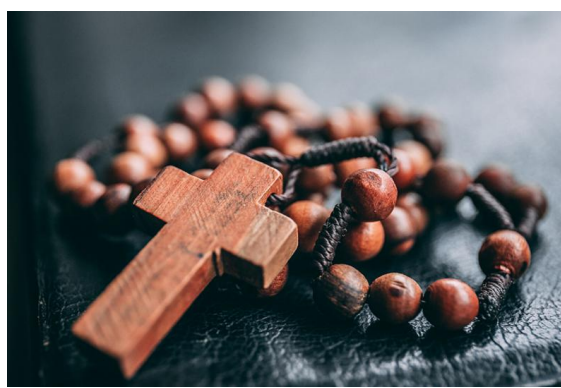
