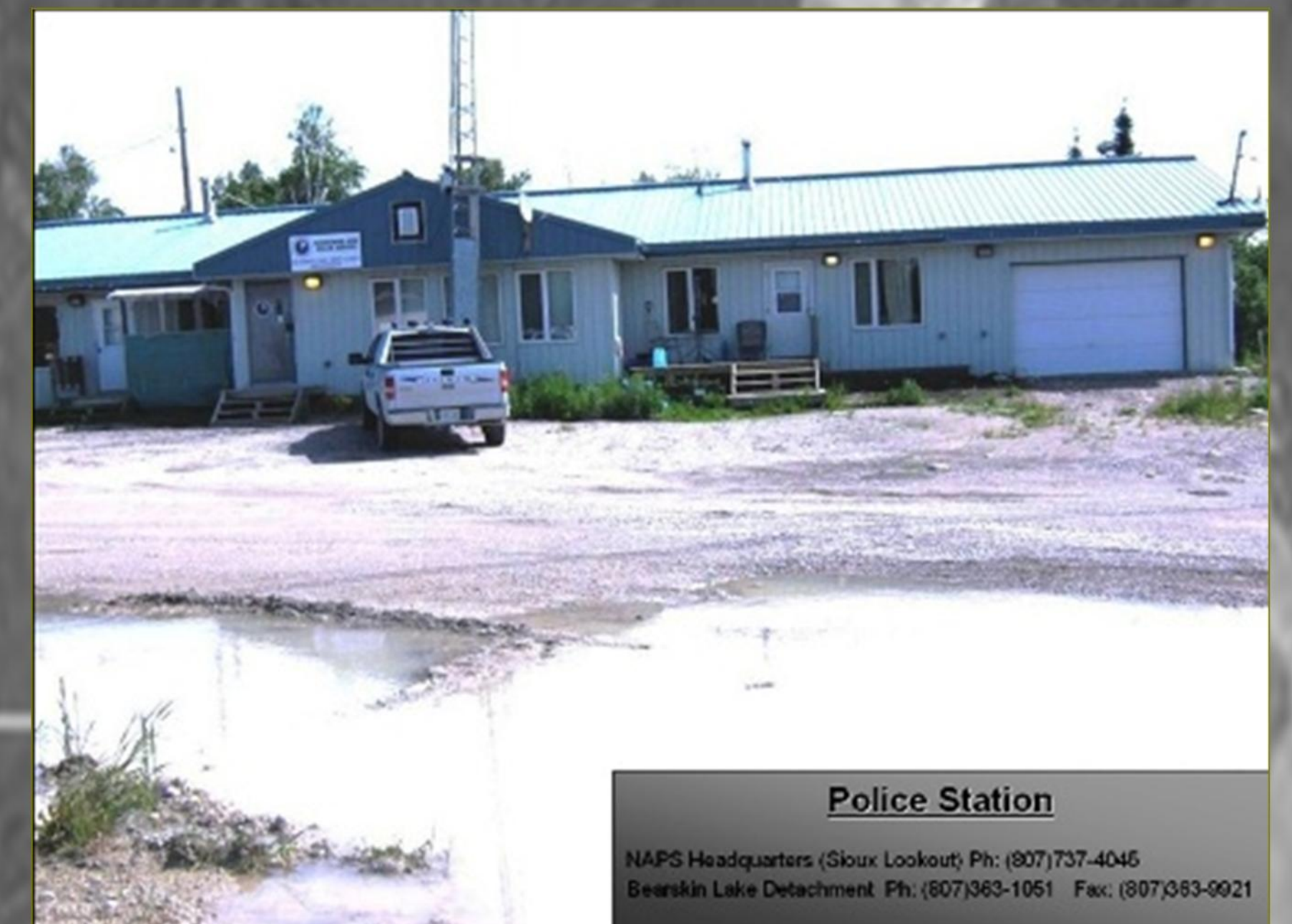
AFFES Northern Community Profile Tool



Background:

The Far North Community Profile Tool was developed to enhance preparedness and protection for communities located in the Far North. The project was developed to assist both AFFES and Emergency Management personnel with response planning as it relates to emergency response in Northern communities. This project also provides emergency response personnel from across the province, such as; EMO (Toronto/PEOC), SSM (MNR/MEOC) with an updated Fire Response Plan, based on updated Hazard Identification and Risk Assessment (HIRA).

Tool Functionality:

- Provides community Fire Protection plans for Far North communities to enhance preparedness and protection for residents.
- Digital images and contact information of key values in each community.
- Support Emergency Management applications (Emergency response/evacuations).
- Allows local Fire Management Headquarters (FMH) to better plan as it relates to the deployment of personnel and equipment.
- Conducts a forest fire HIRA which shows areas of increased risk to communities.
- Developing a web-based tool that provides for display of each Far North community.
- Sets out a values protection scenario in the event of a wildfire threat.
- Will be utilized to assist personnel within any organization the ability to orientate if being positioned within any Far North Community.
